Joseph W. Courson

Joseph W. Courson, age 80, passed away peacefully on Friday, January 11, 2008, at his home. Joe was born in Stuart, FL, and received his Bachelor of Music degree from Stetson University in 1950. Joe began his teaching career at Madison High School in Madison County Florida in 1950. In 1951, he moved to Quincy High School and on to Havana High School in 1952. His final move was to Titusville High School in Brevard County in 1955. Joe remained at THS until his retirement in 1981. As a Charter Member of Omega Chapter of Phi Beta Mu, Joe served as Chapter President as well as the President of the Florida Bandmasters Association. He had a very positive influence on all of the young people he came in contact with either as a director or as judge. He always had an outstanding program and was always on call to help new, as well as veteran directors, whenever they had questions or challenges with their programs. He was a member of the Mims United Methodist Church, a Life Member of the Free and Accepted Masons, and a proud member of the Confederate Sons Association Indian River Camp 47. Joe was predeceased last year by his wife of 56 years, Sara. We miss them both very much.
