Directors, please check the lists for any errors. If there is a problem with your student's listing or with All-State attendance, Contact Mr. **Chuck Fulton** IMMEDIATELY so that substitutions can be made (SCHOOL: **863-688-2771x237**; HOME: **863-619-5110**). DO NOT ALLOW STUDENTS OR PARENTS TO CALL. DIRECTORS MUST **NOT** MAKE SUBSTITUTIONS.

**REMEMBER**: Students MAY be re-auditioned at the Clinic for seating within each section or subsection (i.e., 2nd trumpets, etc.) at the discretion of the Conductor/Clinician.
