The Chairman shared an E-mail stating that, for personal

reasons, John Nista was resigning his position as District Secretary. The chairman informed members that a discussion will be held later in the meeting to resolve this issue.

A discussion of hte restructure of Concert Band Performance Assessment at the state level will eliminate the sight-reading phase. An adjudictor will now provide a clinic for performing bands on their performances.
