FSMA/FMEA Legislative Alert - April 19, 2005

HB 879 passed the Florida House of Representatives this afternoon. The bill language is:

"The Department of Education shall evaluate the extent to which the Sunshine State Standards in the arts are being taught in each school district in kindergarten through grade 12. The evaluation shall include an analysis of student FCAT achievement levels compared to Sunshine State Standards arts instruction and enrollment in art courses. The results of this evaluation shall be provided to the Governor, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the President of the Senate by December 1, 2005."

We view this bill as a preliminary step in the effort to address Fine Arts instruction in public schools. The bill's sponsor, Representative Dorothy Hukill, Volusia, has indicated her strong interest in following up the study's results with a substantive bill. As in the past, the grassroots of our community have attracted a fair amount of attention as the bill progressed through the committee structure in the House.

The bill (HB 879) will be sent to the Florida Senate which will either address it or take up its own bill, SB 126 for further consideration. When we know what action is taken by the Florida Senate, we will let you know.

Please do send Rep. Hukill (<u>dorothy.hukill@myfloridahouse.gov</u>) a brief note thanking her for her efforts on behalf of Fine Arts education.
