- -Thanks to the clinicians who mentioned music advocacy issues at the All-County and All-State concerts and the recent letters to the editor from students and teachers.
- -According to the FSMA website, the following are the general legislative talking points that we should mention as areas of concern:
 - -protect the dedicated fine arts credit for high school graduation
 - -oppose efforts to require 225 minutes per week for PE in grades 6-8
 - -need to have middle school fine arts course requirement
 - -include the fine arts in any revision of the Sunshine State Standards or World Class Standards
- -General consensus is that we are NOT contacting our legislators on these issues. Remember how many positions were lost last year? Remember the 1970's?
- -FMEA website makes it easy to locate House and Senate leaders.
