LATE FINES: \$50.00 for submitting forms late (Payable to FBA) No forms accepted after Sept 7. Band director must be a member of FMEA/FBA by September 1 in order for students audition for all-state. **CD recorders (including mics, etc.) will be collected starting next week** by John Jarvis and Music Man reps and brought to Mike Fraley at Boca Raton MS by Sept. 7. He will test each one and write down instructions for each recorder. Morning of All-State auditions, recorders/monitors will meet early to do a test audition with each one.

Brass/Woodwind auditions will be 15 minutes, Jazz/Percussion auditions will be 20 minutes.

There will be two backup/overflow recording rooms to handle emergency situations (i.e. blank CD's) and to help if a room gets behind schedule.

Michelle from Music Man will pick up your CD recorders the first week of September and deliver them to Boca MS. Please label your unit. This year we are adding recorders from Odyssey MS, JIL HS, Unity School & Park Vista.
