Bring back new music/addition reading sessions during FMEA

Suggestion – put together a band made up of directors (Hillsborough county even) to read down the new middle school music and grade 4. The grade 5-6 may not be accessible, but a reading band as we did at the summer convention. The chair of the music committee could be the conductor since they are the ones who selected the music and could share info about each piece.

Amy Collins for an oboe clinic at FMEA- Stellar Oboe Products

Rhythm and Brass for a session at FMEA- Dallas Brass was invited – this is another wonderful group – they could perform and give clinics on their instrument? They could also be the group that comes around to the band rehearsals??

Jean Berger Horn clinic at FMEA

Create an area where all instruments can be tried out in the exhibit hall

Rationale: people are being told they can't play too long on instruments – if someone is going to spend around \$1000 or more for an instrument, they should be able to try it out at all dynamic levels – this is not allowed because of the noise.

Create more instrument specific clinics so directors can pick up tricks/techniques on those instruments.

Rationale: the Midwest clinic offers these and they are usually fantastic even if it is just an opportunity to hear a professional on that particular instrument. With budget becoming more an issue, private lessons are harder to afford by most families and directors would like to "refreshed" on the instruments. Solo repertoire should be involved in this for all levels – including middle school – resource - the FBA S&E list.

MOTION I: To allow Jazz Bands to perform at Jazz MPA for a rating as long as the Bass part is being covered by another instrument - D. Dubay and C. Sleeper.

RATIONAL: A Bass part can be covered by a keyboard or a tuba and still keep the integrity of the music. Not all Band programs are able to accommodate a Bassist for MPA.

MOTION II: Propose that the Solo and Ensemble committee consider allowing Bass Clarinet students to perform from the Bb Clarinet ensemble list - R. Morris and K. Lewis

RATIONAL: There are currently no trio/quartet ensemble music on the list for bass clarinet, and excludes them from being included. Also, this could apply to Tenor sax and Bari sax trios. If this is being allowed, then the handbook should be changed to reflect this.
