7.6 - Marching Band motion:

Read the proposed motion and the best practices for marching band (URL Below) http://www.flmusiced.org/fba/dnn/performances/bestpracticesformarchingband/tabid/188/default.aspx

Motion: Conte/Dunsizer: limit the number of Marching Band Field Evaluations to a total of four per school year, one of which must include Florida Bandmasters Association Marching Music Performance Assessment. High Schools that do not comply with this requirement will not be eligible to participate in any other Florida Bandmasters Association events for the remainder of the school year.

Rationale: - In order to align our activities with the FBA philosophy and the "best practices" for Marching band, it is necessary to establish an equitable balance between different aspects of the band programs. Excessive participation in Marching band competitions has potential ramifications for our profession, including excessive fees, lower retention rates which may effect teacher units, and de-emphasis of other significant aspects of our curriculum.

Marching Band Motion – District 18 meeting #2 Discussion

The district tried to keep the discussion to no more that 15 – 20 minutes

- Richard Brown made the point that marching band is a vital part of the WHOLE high school band experience.
- Paxen Roan stated that we are professionals and FBA should treat us as such. If we are truly professionals in our field we should not be told "what to do" with our own programs.
- Linda Mann made the comment that this MAY have started a few years ago when there were a
 few schools that had a problem with principals thinking that their band programs were "exploiting"
 students and charging excessive fees.
- One of the biggest concerns that District 18 (as a whole) has is the fear that if this motion is passed it will cause a huge rift between the younger directors and FBA.... Causing directors to not join FBA or move to another state.
- Rod Chesnutt mentioned that he has been in many states and this is happening in other states and that we must remember that sports are considered extra curricular while band is STILL curricular.
- The question was asked "does this include bowl games and major national parades?
- District 18 unanimously OPPOSES this motion.

FBA Ex. Director Duane Hendon States:

If FBA does not do anything about this issue, someone else will and you may not like it. If the board votes YES, then it will come before the membership at our meeting on Thursday at convention.
