### "I'm interested! What do I do now?

- Become endorsed via online exam.
- Candidates who score all sample auditions within a certain range will be endorsed
  - Note: Candidates whose scores do not qualify are encouraged review the training and apply again
- Log in to your www.flmusiced.org user account; under FEMEA select "All-State Adjudicator Training"
- Review the training video, or just go straight to the Adjudication Exam

#### **Adjudication Process**

- FEMEA assigns @30 judges each year from the bank of endorsed adjudicators
- Late September: judges begin to score assigned auditions from any web-based device
- > 10-day window
- Each audition scored by 3 judges; auditions are assigned randomly
- Each judge scores approximately 70 entries
- > Time to score each entry: about 5 minutes
- Honorarium paid upon closing of adjudication window and successful completion of assigned scored student entries

## **Important Consideration for Adjudicators**

- 4 = EXEMPLARY
- If qualities of more than one point level are present, the student should be assigned the lower point value
- Listen multiple times, if necessary
