The recent action of the Dade County School Board in regard to Junior High School Bands received some state-wide newspaper publicity in which the Board's action was misinterpreted to some extent. The Dade County Board of Public Instruction has adopted the following points of policy for Junior High Instrumental Music. (As recommended by Jr. High School Principals and Bandmasters)

1. Jr. High Bands will confine their activities to those of an educational nature.
2. Inexpensive uniforms will be used and will be purchased by the schools themselves.
3. In Jr. High schools under 500 enrollment either Band or Orchestra may be emphasized; In Jr. High schools over 500 both Band and Orchestra may be emphasized.
4. School tax money will be used to purchase instruments. Minimum equipment standards to be set by a committee of Jr. High Principals and Bandmasters.

Consult the FMEA Bulletin (issued a few days ago) in regard to the overall clinic program which also included Orchestra, Chorus, and Elementary school music.

The Membership Committee has on file a number of applications which are being held for certificate information which is obtained from the State Department and also for letters of recommendation from present FBA members.

All efforts will be made at the clinic to complete the processing of these applications. Bandmasters with applications pending are extended all privileges of membership (except vote) at the clinic and are cordially invited to attend and make the most of this event.
