Item 4: Treasurer's Report

1. B. Sego: Approximately \$17,000 current balance left. Only about \$7,000 left to pay; should leave an approximate balance of \$10,000 at the end of the year.

Item 5: Announcements, etc.

- 1. Secretary position: K. Smith: has accepted directors position in Louisiana and will be leaving Florida at the end of the summer.
- 2. Nominations for new secretary:

- 3. Vote taken by secret ballet: Rich Ervin will serve District 8 as their secretary for 2004-2005.

Item 6: Advocacy Issues with FBA and FMEA

1. Discussed the importance of legislative alerts and concert opportunities.

Item 7: Unfinished Business

- 1. Complete Adjudicator Evaluation Forms for S&E and Concert MPA.
- 2. <u>Marching Date</u>: concern over conflicts with FMBC. Jon stated that he would be willing to change dates if we got him in the citrus bowl either that night or to the next weekend. The citrus bowl said no; therefore, the conflict remains. Discussion:
 - a) M. Howard: If we move dates, we'd have to move venue. We might not be able to get the citrus bowl back in the future. Same concerns echoed by M. Flanagan later in discussion.
 - b) J. LaCagnata: Continue with the dates as is and FBA be flexible with scheduling; also stated that he is adamant about continuing at the citrus bowl.
 - c) K. Pearce: FBA needs to do what's best for them and not worry about FMBC.
 - d) B. Sego: could loose gate money due to lack of attendance if the conflict was not resolved.
 - e) M. Parks: still have conflicts with FOA All-County. Wind & percussion students doing double duty.
 - f) R. Thomas: have we looked into having Marching MPA on a Thursday. Some concerns about gate money.
 - g) MOTION: Accept the November 13, 2004 date for District 8 Marching MPA at the Citrus Bowl with times and scheduling structure to be determined. (B. Reineke / C. Perez) PASSED
- 3. <u>Plaques for next year</u> MOTION: We will not have plaques at Marching MPA, but some alternative, inexpensive form of recognition will be provided to each school. (A. Lefkowitz / Missie Ellis) PASSED
- 4. <u>Phone calls for donations</u> Each school agreed to find one parent to volunteer to make calls to sponsors for donations for using the Citrus Bowl.

- 2. B. Sego: trying to find a summer group willing to brainstorm some ways to lower assessment.

- 2. J. Berry: Would like to see food provided for band directors at MPA's in order to increase comradery.

Item 14: Proposals to the Executive Board

- 1. <u>PROPOSAL</u>: Change the sightreading music so that MD and MC bands read different levels of music. <u>RATIONALE</u>: The MD bands are usually performing lower grades of music on stage so they should not read the same level as MC bands in the sightreading room. (J. Berry / J. Eaddy) PASSED
- 2. <u>PROPOSAL</u>: Find "suitable" music for the Middle School Sight reading MPA. (J. Berry / A. Powell) <u>RATIONALE</u>: This year the MC and MD bands read the same thing and the music was on the level of beginning band in the 1st semester. The music should be a little more challenging to make Sightreading worthwhile. (J. Berry / A. Powell) PASSED

4. <u>PROPOSAL</u>: The middle school All-State requirements for flute, chromatic scale should be changed from E-flat to E-flat two octaves to C to C, three octaves. <u>RATIONALE</u>: The current requirement of E-flat to E-flat gives our students the impression that they can and, reasonably might, make the all-state band by simply fulfilling this requirement for this scale. However, the reality is that most, if not all, flute students who place into the all-state band play their chromatic scale from C to C, three octaves. Having the current lower standard gives our students a false sense of hope that they will be placed into the group because they have fulfilled their chromatic scale requirement. On the other hand, the proposed requirement would only serve to raise the standard for our auditioning middle school flute students. This proposed requirement is already perceived as an unwritten expectation.
