S&E Rule Change – Auxiliary Change:

Directors with auxiliaries need to take note of an S&E rule change: An individual student may be entered in the following events, but **NO INDIVIDUAL MAY BE ENTERED IN MORE THAN TWO TWIRLING/AUXILAIRY ENSEMBLES OF ANY KIND OR COMBINATION LIMIT: TWO** solo events/ TWO Twirling, Guard, Dance Ensembles. The 2 solos must have different equipment or one may be dance, and the 2 ensembles must have different equipment. A student may also perform an instrumental solo or ensemble as long as the total number of solos does not exceed 2 and the overall limit of 4 S&E events is observed.
