The leadership that has evolved this site and the concept of "idearaisers" as described at the site will be moving to advance many of the ideas, presumably those which have been rated highly by many viewers.

The "Education" portion of the site is extensive and you will find a number of ideas that you will want to rate highly (especially those relating to music or fine arts education!). As you read you may also find ideas that you may want to mark in other ways to either encourage or discourage the Legislative leaders about them.

If you would like to simply find the "arts" articles, a word search is available and will narrow the scope down easily.

Some of the ideas have as many as 200 "ratings." I encourage you to pay particular attention to the fine arts education topics and enlist the assistance of your booster communities in making certain that our concern about a fully balanced curriculum is heard. As with all political issues, the larger our group of concern citizens, the higher music and fine arts education is elevated.

Congratulations to John and Rich and the Winter Park Wind Ensemble who will be featured on the FMEA Presidents Concert Wednesday evening in Tampa.

Be conscious of new hotel procedures!

There are new policies you need to be aware of regarding hotel arrangements for Tampa this year. Supposedly, the hotels are not to accept any additional reservations for the FMEA block until September 1st. If you have already made reservations for next year, FMEA is advising you to reconfirm your reservation on September 1st to make certain you are in the FMEA block and are receiving the convention rate. Each director is allowed to reserve 5 rooms (only). You must submit a rooming list complete with names by December 1st or your rooms will be canceled. The last day to cancel rooms is December 8th. You will be charged the total amount of your reservation if you cancel past that date.

This new policy is because FSMA gets charged for rooms that are cancelled on short notice. This has cost FSMA thousands of dollars.

Both the middle school audition band and the middle school honor band will rehearse at the new Embassy Suites right across from the convention center.
