



# **B** Section

Distribute one ball to participants. Cup the ball in one hand and "clap" the ball with the other hand to make a tapping sound.

B1: Tap the ball on beats 1 and 5 during the first repeat. 4x

B2: Tap the ball on beats 2 and 6 during the second repeat. 4x

B3: Tap the ball on beats 3 and 7 during the third repeat. 4x

B4: Tap the ball on beats 4 and 8 during the final repeat. 4x

A B1 A B2 A B3 A B4 Coda: A plus B combo

Drummers "create" a movement for the echo in the A section Ball players "create" a tapping game with a partner
